Who does God say you are?

Believe it!

In this lesson, we want you to understand who God says you are instead of just learning some new evangelistic techniques. Once you realize Who God says you are, you will begin to act out of your identity instead of just dead works. The Bible is the word of God that is able to transform a life. The Father has a lot to say about who you are and what you can do. In this lesson, we will look into God's word and unlock your identity. Get ready to be changed from the inside out. The real you is about to be unleashed! When you realize you are not common, you will begin to do uncommon things!

Once you know your identity, you will be released into your destiny!

Let's look at some people who knew who they were and see how it allowed them to do what God had called them to do. Who did God say they were?

1. Jesus- (Matt 3:17) You are My son in whom I love and in whom I am well pleased. God said he was His son and that he was accepted. (Matt 4:3) The devil instantly tried to question what God said in an attempt to abort Jesus' destiny. (John 4:26)- Jesus said, "**I am** He that speaks to you." Jesus knew he was the Savior of the world and that he was anointed to do what he did. (Luke 4:18)

2. John the Baptist-(John 1:23,33)- "**I am** the voice of one calling in the desert, Make straight the way for the Lord." John knew he was not the Christ, he was not Elijah, but he was the forerunner for the Lord.

-When you **don't** know who you are, you will try to be someone else.

3. Paul-(1 Cor 1:1)- Paul called to be an apostle...(Acts 26:16-18) Paul knew he was called to go to the Gentiles and turn them to Jesus.

Who does God say you are?

21 Truths that God has revealed about you in his Word.

1. (2 Cor 5:17)- Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come.

Truth - I am a new creation in Christ.

2. (John 1:12-13)-Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become the children of God-children not born of natural descent or human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

Truth - I am born of God.

3. (Gal 3:26)-You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.

Truth-I am a _____ or _____ of God.

4. (Dan 11:32)-Those that know their God will do exploits for him.

Truth-I know God and will do great exploits for him.

5. (Matt 5:13)- You are the salt of the earth.

Truth-I am the salt of the earth.

6. (Matt 5:14)-You are the light of the world.

Truth -I am the light of the world.

7. (2Cor 3:6)-He has made us competent (adequate) ministers of a new covenant.

Truth -I am an adequate minister.

8. (2Cor 5:19amp.) committing to us the message of reconciliation.

Truth -I am a messenger of _____. My message is that God and man can be reconciled.

9. (2Cor 5:20)-So we are Christ's ambassadors, as though God making his appeal as it were through us.

Truth-I am an ambassador of Christ.

10. (Rom 8:11)-if the same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead lives in you...

Truth-The same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead lives in me.

11. (Matt 4:19)-Come follow me and I will make you fishers of men.

Truth-God is making me into a _____ of men.

12. (1John 4:4)-Greater is He in me than he that is in the world.

Truth- The Holy Spirit in me is greater than any demonic spirit.

13. (2Tim 1:7)- For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but a spirit of love, power, and a sound mind.

Truth- I am not fearful because I have not been given a spirit of fear.

14. (Prov 28:1) the righteous are as bold as a lion.

Truth- Because Jesus has made me righteous, I am as bold as a lion.

15. (Rom 5:5) The love of God has been shed abroad in your heart.

Truth- I have a great love for the lost because God's love is in my heart.

16. (Acts 1:8)-you shall receive power to be a witness.

Truth-I have been empowered to be a witness.

17. (Mark 16:17-18)-these signs will follow those who believe...they will cast out devils....they will lay their hands on the sick and they will recover.

Truth-Because I believe, I cast out devils and when I lay my hands on _____ people, they recover.

18. (Mark 16:15)-Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

Truth- Because my Lord told me to, I will preach the gospel to those around me.

19. (2 Tim 4:2)-preach the word. Be prepared in season and out of season.

Truth- I will always be prepared to preach the gospel.

20. (Rom 12:2)-be transformed (changed) by the renewing of your mind.

Truth-I am being changed into who God made me to be because I am renewing my mind.

21. (Prov 11:30)-he who wins souls is wise.

Truth-I am a soul winner.

Jesus said in John 8:32, “You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.” To walk in who God says you are you must first know some things. You have just heard who God says you are and what He says you can do.

There is story of a man who was a passenger on a cruise who after buying his ticket to a beautiful week long cruise to the Caribbean, resided in his cabin eating cheese and crackers all week while the captain saved him a seat at the head table full of prime rib, lobster, and all that his heart could desire. When it was time to depart, the captain met the passenger on the boardwalk, and said, “I missed you all week in the dining room.” The passenger replied, “I had just enough for the ticket so I couldn’t afford the meals.” To his surprise, the captain replied, “When you bought your ticket for the cruise, it included all your meals.” You can go your whole life on your trip to heaven, but miss out on the meals. You need to know some things, and the truth will make you free.

Now your part is to _____ what you have heard in your heart and confess it with your mouth and act on it. That is faith. In Heb 4:2 it says, “For we also had the gospel preached to us just as they did; but the message they heard had no value to them, because those who heard, did not combine it with faith. It is no different from when you were saved. You heard the truth. Faith comes by hearing. Rom 10:9-10 says “that when you believed in your heart that God raised Jesus from the dead and confessed him as your Lord, you will be saved.” Rom 10:8 says, “the word is near you. It is in your mouth and your heart, that is the word of faith we are proclaiming.”

So let’s end this lesson with a **Citytaker Confession**. **Make this a daily confession of your faith!**

I am a new creation in Christ, a son or daughter of God. I have been born of God himself, and I will do great exploits for Him. The same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead lives in me, He ministers through me. I am the salt of the earth. I am the light of the world. I am an ambassador of Christ, an adequate minister and people are reconciled with God through me. I am a messenger of reconciliation. I am a fisher of men. I am a soul winner. Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world. I am not intimidated by anyone or any circumstance because I have not been given a spirit of fear. I am as bold as a lion and I proclaim the gospel with power, authority, and with the love which has been shed abroad in my heart. I cast out devils. I lay hands on the sick and they recover. I will always be prepared to preach the gospel to everyone around me. I am being changed as I believe God’s word about me. I am a member of the army of God and He is using me to help take this city.

This is who God says you are. Believe it!
