# Lesson 7

## *Every Believer's Destiny is Evangelistic!*

Do you know why you are here? Do you what God's will is for your life? Do you know what you are called to do? Now that you are born again, the Lord has a wonderful, specific plan for your life. (Jer 29:11) We were all created different and have different works that we were created for. (Eph 2:10) You are not here by chance. You have been born of God, not of human decision. (John 1:12-13) You have been placed in this generation, in this country, in this city, and even in this group for a purpose. You have even been led into this Citytaker Training Bootcamp. (Prov 20:24)

**History is not a divine force set in stone. It is the servant of those who make it. (Book of Acts) You are called to make some history!**

### **DISCOVERING YOUR DESTINY-**

Briefly, here is a quick tool that will help you discover God's destiny for you. Answer these 2 questions that are go to help you discover your purpose and your destiny!

**Q-1-What do you see as the world's greatest problems from your perspective?** Let's look at Moses' life. He was passionate about having the Israelites free from oppression. (Ex 2:11-14) Paul was zealous for the truth to be exhorted. (Act 22:3-4) They had experiences and passions that shaped their future.

You have seen, heard, felt, and went through events that have prepared you for your ministry or purpose. (2 Cor 1:4)

## DESIRES

**Many people think when they begin to think about asking God for his plans for their life that he is going to immediately send them to Africa to witness to the pigmies with spitguns.**

**Phillipians 2:13** says, “It is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose. (Read in the Amplified Bible) If God was sending you to Africa to witness to the pigmies, you would have the desire to leave here and get to Africa immediately and you would have a passion in your heart for those people.

**(FIVEFOLDMINISTRY)-1 Tim 3-**if any of you desire to be an overseer, you desire a noble task. Who told Phillip and Steven to be evangelists? They were commissioned to be deacons. **They had the \_\_\_\_\_.**

What are those desires that don't seem to be going away? Guess who put them there? Who told David to kill Goliath in 1 Sam 17? Who's idea was it for Peter to walk on water? Isaiah 55:6 says, “His ways are now your ways and his thoughts are your thoughts.” Psalm 37:4 says delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart.

Once your will has been consecrated to God, \_\_\_\_\_. Your desire is to serve and please Him by using all the resources you have. Not your will but his be done. (Luk 22:42) Luke 1:3 talking about Luke's reason for writing one of the 4 gospels of the New Testament says, “it seemed good to me most excellent Theopolis...”. **It seemed good to you!** You mean you didn't see an angel or the glory cloud Luke telling you to write this gospel? Your desire is your call. Again in Acts 15:28 when the early church leaders were deciding which of the Jewish commands to pass down to the new Gentile church they said, “\_\_\_\_\_ and the Holy Spirit...” It seemed to good to us. Your desire is your call. What seems good to you now that your will is consecrated to the Lord?

You will even do things that are not for your best interest but to fulfill the call. (Acts 21:13-14)

**Q-2-If you could do what ever you wanted everyday and you would be doing it every day for the rest of your life what would you choose to do?**

-It must be good for God, good or others, and fulfilling your desires!

Some might say that is presumptuous. Whatever you desire is your call? Remember. Once your will is consecrated to the Lordship of Jesus! You know

what is right and wrong. (Prov. 10:32)-the lips of the righteous know what is acceptable.

Many Christians are using their gift in the world to make money. That's fine. If they would use it for the kingdom as well, they would prosper in the kingdom also.

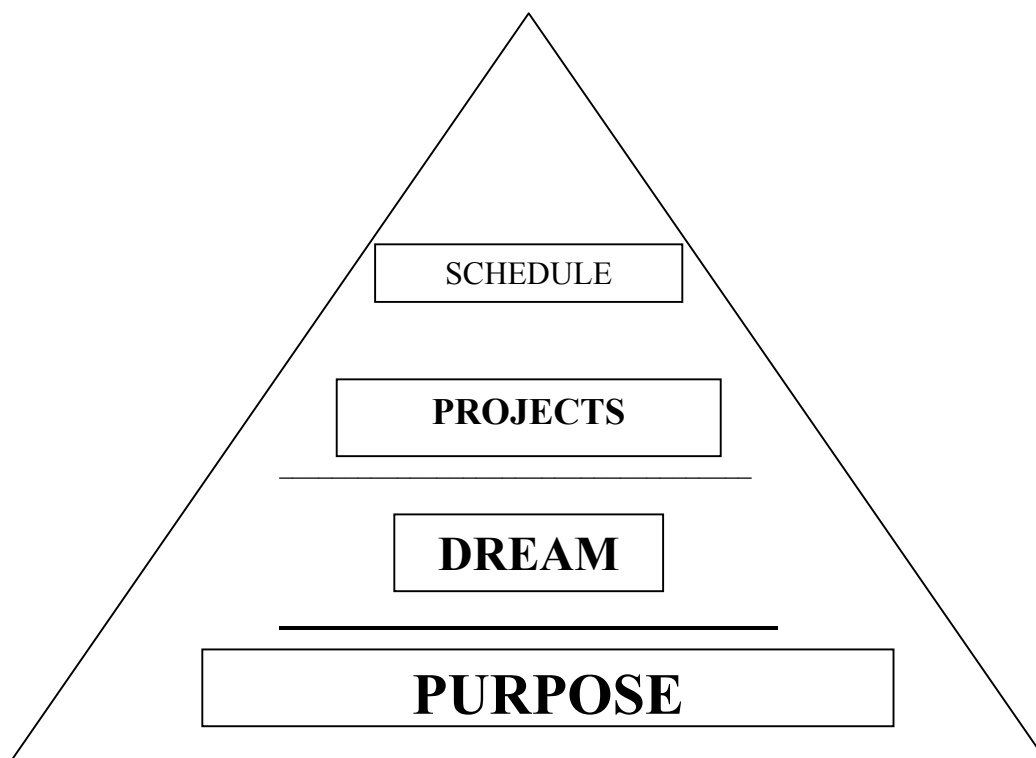
Your gift will make room for you. (Prov 18:16) Work your gift like David in the pasture and you will see greatness.

## Passion Pyramid



**Purpose**-Once you have laid the foundation of your purpose or your calling, you are ready to get more specific by looking at your dreams.

**Dreams**- There is power, energy, and hope in a dream. Your dream will manifest in a strong permanent desire. What do you want?

**Cesar Castellanos, the founder of the G12 cell model says, “\_\_\_\_\_are the language of the Holy Spirit.”**

**We’ve all heard Martin Luther’s I have a dream.... How about you? What would you like to do if you knew you couldn’t fail? What would you be willing to invest your time and money to do or to have?**

**Your dream is the reward of the price you pay to accomplish your projects. (Heb 12:2-for the joy set before him endured the cross)**

**Schedule-** By following this Passion Pyramid, you are always assuring yourself that your daily calendar is filled with things aligned with your purpose. (Prov 13:4) the desires of the diligent are fully satisfied. You've got to work your gift. Do you see a man skilled in his work? He will serve before kings; he will not serve before obscure men (Prov 22:29) **Remember, the amount of \_\_\_\_\_ that you are willing to apply to your life, not desire, determines your destiny.**

**Live on purpose, not on accident!**

## **PROVISION FOR THE VISION**

When you ask people that are broke they normally tell you that they hate their job. When you ask a wealthy person they love what they do. The trick is to do what you \_\_\_\_\_ using your gifts, and prosperity will normally follow. (I Kings 17)Elijah from the brook to the widow woman.

God pays for what he orders.

“When you are involved in your life’s work you can’t differentiate between work and play. You’ll find yourself up at 3 in the morning working your gift because you love it and it’s backed with a passion and a purpose. It’s fun. You will wake up to live. (Acts 13:36)-“For when David had fulfilled his purposes in his generation, he fell asleep.”

A man or women that has consecrated themselves to the Lord and have been anointed are \_\_\_\_\_ until they have completed their mission! (John 10:39)

**Your destiny involves helping others meet Jesus,  
the door to their destiny!**

**The five purposes your were created are:**

1. To \_\_\_\_\_ Him (John 4:23)
2. To be part of His family (Heb 2:13b)
3. To become like Him (Rom 8:29)
4. To \_\_\_\_\_ Him (Eph 2:10)
5. To tell others about Him (John 17:18)

**The whole church, not just the apostles were told to go into all the world and preach and teach the good news. (Mark 16:15, Matt 28:19-20)**

Reinhardt Bonnke says, “To reach the whole world it is going to take the \_\_\_\_\_.” The body of Christ must reach into every nook and cranny of a city so as to reach them all. Pastors and evangelists cannot meet them all and God has put them on your path so that you may be privileged to share in his glory and his sufferings.

**Can a whole city hear the gospel?**

(Acts 19:10) It is said about Paul in Ephesus that, “this (teaching) went on for two years so that all the Jews and Greeks who lived in the province of Asia heard the word of the Lord. Only if the whole church is ministering and speaking the gospel. Jesus challenged the church of \_\_\_\_\_ to return to their first love. (Rev 2:4) What was that first love? To know God and to make Him known. Seeing people saved. If you claim to love Jesus, and by His Spirit He lives in you, then just like Jesus came to seek and save that which was lost, so will you! (Luk19: 10) He was known as a friend of sinners (Matt11: 19). How about you?

The function of the five-fold ministry is to \_\_\_\_\_ the saints for the work of the ministry. (Eph 4:11-12) You are a saint (believer) and you are to do the work (labor) of the ministry! (Matt 9:37-38)

So no matter what God has called you to do (homemaker, attorney, business owner, student, or five-fold minister (Paul told Timothy to do the work of an evangelist)); you are to be evangelistic. No matter what your occupation or calling we are all called to live a life where they will see our good deeds and praise our heavenly Father. (Matt 5:16). There are many things you can do to be evangelistic.

In the book of Acts we see that God was adding to their number daily those that were getting saved. (Acts 2:47) We see many different people all working together accomplishing many different tasks to bring people to Jesus.

1. We see 120 and others praying. (Acts 1:14-15)(Acts 4:24)
2. We see some preaching. (Acts 2:14)
3. They gave of their resources to meet tangible needs. (Acts 2:45)(Acts 4:34)
4. People ministered in the gift of helps to assist people getting healed. (Acts 5:15)
5. They distributed food. (Acts 6:3)
6. They wrote so others could read. (Acts 1:1)
7. They all shared the \_\_\_\_\_. (Acts 8:1,4) Who? What? Where?

**Yes we must all live a holy Christ-like life but we cannot stop there.**

**Someone has to speak the gospel to them.**

**Romans 10:14-17-** How then can they call on the one they have not believed in? How can they believe in the one in whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone \_\_\_\_\_ to them? And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written, “how beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news? (John 20:21)

Feet are made to take you somewhere. (Eph 6:15) “With the feet fitted with the readiness of the gospel of peace.”

We come to Jesus (Matt 11:28) and then he tells us to \_\_\_ into all the world! Your evangelistic destiny is so important not only did he tell you in all the gospels (Matt 28:19) (Mark 16:15) (Luke 24:47) (John 20:21), it was the last He said before he ascended. (Acts 1:8)

Jesus is sending you to walk into your world and be Jesus, live Jesus, and preach Jesus to them. (John 20:21) You are a \_\_\_\_\_ (sent one) into the home, neighborhood, workplace, family, and city where you are. You are the spirit filled, God loving Christian sitting in evangelistic training meetings. Who do you think God is getting ready to use in your circle of influence? Smile!

- We should all be looking for people God puts on our path and share the gospel with them.
- We have been given the ministry of \_\_\_\_\_ (to establish a close relationship, to settle or resolve) people to God. (2 Cor 5:18) (Paul was speaking to the entire Corinthian church).
- We are all Christ’s \_\_\_\_\_ (a messenger or representative for a period of time) and God will make his appeal to the world through you (2 Cor 5:20)

Stop and think where you were and what your life was like five minutes before you received the forgiveness of your sin. **Go tell them!**

Freely you have been given, freely give. (Matt10:8) Don't hoard the greatest gift. If you had the cure to cancer or the winning Lotto numbers, would you tell anyone else? If they don't hear now they will either go to hell or be executed for their faith. GO!

Time is running out. The only thing we will not be able to do in heaven is to share the gospel. We will be able to \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, but not evangelize.

**A large part of your destiny (why you are here) is to share the forgiveness of sins through Jesus Christ with a lost and dying world!**

**You effort will have eternal significance for others!** The gospel works. God is going to use you and people's lives are going to be changed. People are going to meet Jesus and be saved because of you. You are getting equipped! Look out devil. Here comes a Citytaker!

What God has called you to do; he will enable you to do. He wants to empower you to have the ability to be a bold compassionate witness.  
(Acts 1:8)
